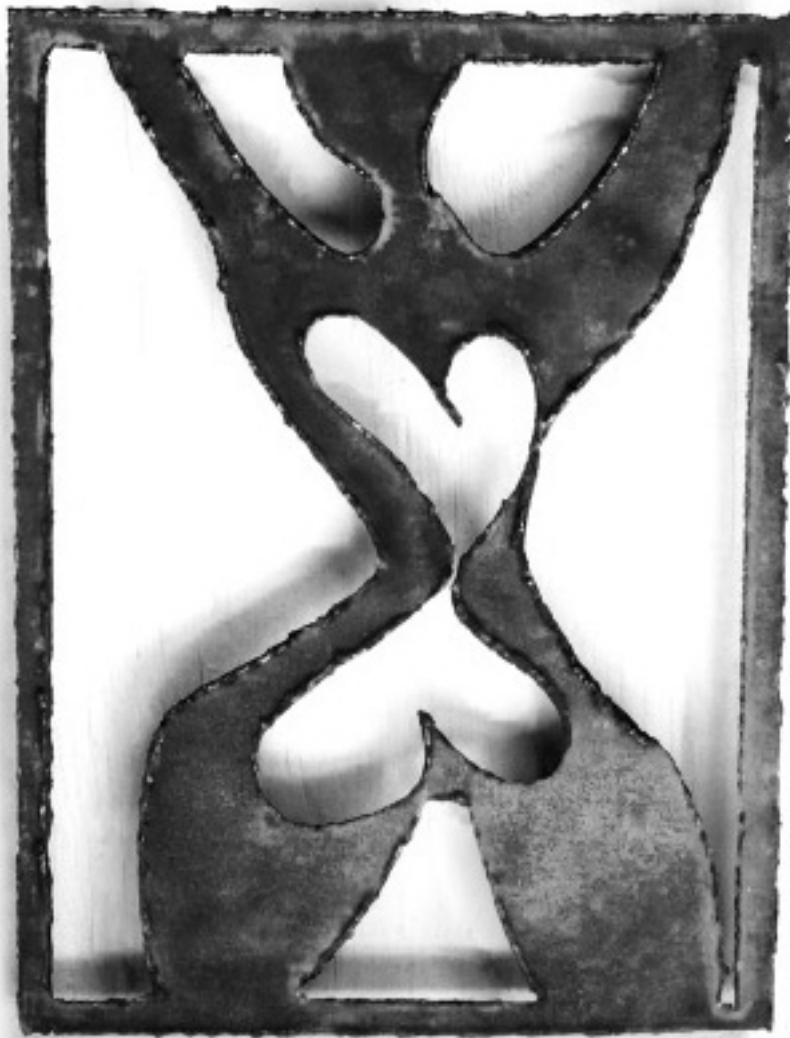


# STUDIO SPOTLIGHT: STEVE BURNETT
